

Fruit trees and vines

Plant	Variety	Fruit/plant qualities
Apple	<i>Fireside</i>	Fruit - Very large size, with crisp, sweet, nonjuicy flavor. Dense, fine texture with thinner skin. Excellent eating apple. Tree - Not self fertile. Use two varieties to be productive.
	<i>Haralred</i>	Fruit - Redder and earlier than Haralson. Fruit is juicy, tart and firm. Tree - Not self fertile. Use two varieties to be productive.
	<i>Haralson</i>	Fruit - Medium to large size. Bright red, tart, crisp and juicy. Excellent for baking, cider and freezing. Tree - Not self fertile. Use two varieties to be productive.
	<i>Honeycrisp</i>	Fruit - medium to large in size. Extremely crisp and juicy, with a balanced flavor. Maintains flavor and crispness. Tree - Not self fertile. Use two varieties to be productive.
	<i>Honeygold</i>	Fruit - Medium to large size. Golden, crisp, juicy and sweet. Tender skin with firm textured flesh. Bruises easily. Tree - Not self fertile. Use two varieties to be productive.
Blueberry	<i>Chippewa</i>	Fruit - Sweet, dark blue fruit with good flavor. Vine - Very productive. Upright growth habit. Use 2-3 varieties for the best fruit and pollination. Winter protection with mulch is necessary.
	<i>Northblue</i>	Fruit - Large, dark blue fruit with good flavor. Vine - Short stature. Self-fruitful. Use 2-3 varieties for the best fruit and pollination. Winter protection with mulch is necessary.
	<i>Northcountry</i>	Fruit - Light blue color, sweet and mild flavor. Vine - Partially self-fruitful. Use 2-3 varieties for the best fruit and pollination. Winter protection with mulch is necessary.
Cherry	<i>Evans Bali</i>	Fruit - Dark red, very sweet fruit. Excellent for baking or eating fresh. Tree - Self fertile. Very hardy buds.
	<i>North Star</i>	Fruit - Red with small stone. Sour cherries excellent for pies.

		Tree - Self fertile. Very productive. Height 8-10'.
Grape	<i>Bluebell</i>	Fruit - Blue-black color. Great for juice and jelly. Vine - Vigorous. Winter protection with mulch is necessary.
	<i>Edelweiss</i>	Fruit - Greenish-white color, very sweet. Good dessert and wine grape. Vine - Vigorous. Winter protection with mulch is necessary.
	<i>Kay Gray</i>	Fruit - Medium to large, white in color. Good for table use and wine. Vine - Very productive. Winter protection with mulch is necessary.
	<i>Swenson Red</i>	Fruit - Red in color, large, round fruit. Sweet, crisp and tender. Vine - Hardy. Winter protection with mulch is necessary.
Pear	<i>Parker Pear</i>	Fruit - Large, yellow-bronze. Fine-grained, juicy and tender. Tree - Self sterile. Need two varieties for good fruit.
	<i>Summercrisp Pear</i>	Fruit - Pyramid-shaped fruit is crisp and sweet. Tree - Self sterile. Need two varieties for good fruit.
Plum	<i>Pipestone Plum</i>	Fruit - Large, red fruit with sweet juicy yellow flesh. Tree - Self sterile. Need two varieties for good fruit.
	<i>Toka Plum</i>	Fruit - Medium size fruit with apricot color and excellent flavor. Tree - Self sterile. Need two varieties for good fruit.
Raspberry	<i>Boyne</i>	Fruit - Red, fragrant fruit excellent for canning, freezing and dessert. Vine - Very productive, erect and sturdy. Self fertile. One large crop per year.
	<i>Heritage</i>	Fruit - Medium size red fruit with good flavor. Vine - Everbearing-first crop in July, second in September. Self fertile.
	<i>Kiwigold</i>	Fruit - Yellow, good size and quality. Vine - Everbearing. Self fertile.
