

## Tips for Attracting Hummingbirds

**Ruby-throated hummingbirds** are the only hummingbirds found in Minnesota. Hummingbirds are migratory and spend their summer months in Minnesota, while they reside in the tropical rainforests of Central America. Hummingbirds are most commonly found on the edges of woods, orchards, and in your garden.

Hummingbirds need tubular flowers that have continual blooms throughout the season. Brightly colored flowers will draw the hummingbirds to your garden. Including red and orange flowers to your garden is a great place to start. Once the hummingbirds find your garden they will investigate all flowers, no matter what color.
