

Tomato Varieties

All varieties carried in 3 1/2" and 1 gallon pots

Beefmaster

Large beefsteak style fruits. High yield plant.
Excellent for salads, sandwiches, canning and drying.

Better Boy

Large, firm, flavorful red fruits. Good yield.
Great for slicing.

Big Boy

Large, firm, meaty red fruits. Sweet and fragrant.
Excellent for salads, slicing and canning.

Brandywine

Large, beefsteak style fruits. Outstanding full flavor.
Moderate yield. Heirloom variety.

Bush Early Girl

Medium size red fruits for slicing and salads.
High yield. Good flavor.

Early Girl

Medium size red fruits for slicing. Early fruit production continues late into the season. Moderately sweet, medium to high acidity.

Grape

Sweet tasting small fruits for salads and snacking. Smaller than a cherry tomato. Excellent flavor.

LaRoma

Bright red pear or plum shaped fruit. Great for salads, sauces, juices and canning.

Lemon Boy

Clear yellow fruit.

Good for salads and slicing.

Rutgers

Globe shaped tomato. Excellent midseason.

Good for slicing and cooking.

Good patio tomato.

Sunstart

Tasty medium fruits. Great fresh or cooked.

Very early producer.

Super Fantastic

Large, bright red, juicy, meaty fruit. Good yield all summer.

Excellent flavor. Good for salads, slicing, canning and drying.

Supersweet 100

Bite sized sweet fruit produced in abundance.

Fruit is low in acidity.
